

Natural Healer Empress Minott

Biography

Empress Minott born Elecia Minott (May 12, 1980) formerly known as Dream is an award winning Toronto Canadian-based Jamaica roots reggae singer, songwriter and creative dancer best known for her singles "Stumbling Blocks" and "Stop Di Fighting" which has a strong presence on the Canadian charts. She has an established fan-base in Europe, Africa, Jamaica, Canada, America and Japan.

he soulful artiste got nominated for 2009 Canadian Reggae Music Award. She was successful by Copping the 2011 Reggae Music Achievement Award for Best Promising Reggae Artist. Empress Minott music continues to make waves in the Canadian reggae circuit with the single "Respect" from the album "Natural Healer" being nominated for Reggae Single of the year 2011 in Canada on the Youth in Progress Awards Show.

Career


In the years since she has been active, Empress Minott has shared the stage with top international reggae artistes which include Romain Virgo, L.U.S.T, Morgan Heritage, Lutan Fyah, Gyptian, Queen Sheba, Bush Man, Sugar Minott, Pinchers, Cocoa T, Boris Gardener, Dobby Dobson, Pluto Shervington, Daddy U-Roy, General Trees, Taurus Riley among others. A career highlight for this roots reggae diva was when she performed with Juno Award winning reggae artist Blessed as well as Exco Levi.

A hard worker on stage Empress Minott brings an energy and flare during her performances that mesmerizes her audience. Her work ethics is to please her listeners no matter the size or the venue.

On March 19, 2011, Empress Minott launched her highly anticipated Album called Natural Healer at least two tracks "Shine" and "Nothing Can Compare" are popular in the European circuit. Her single "Respect" is currently on the top ten charts in Canada and is being recognized worldwide.

Empress Minott's First Major hit single "Show Me" was cemented (well received) in Europe which earned her a number two spot on the Karma Reggae Show Top 10 Count-Down Reggae Chart www.galaxygoldradio.co.uk. The song has made its way on the Rico Vibes Top Ten Reggae charts Atlanta, Georgia on DaFlavRadio where it sat at number four for three of its nine-week stay. She has high respect for the Queen of (roots reggae) radio host, Mama Elise Kelly on Jamaica's leading radio station Irie Fm who has described Empress Minott as very Persistent, and continues to push her Music out to her listening audience.

Empress Minott has been featured in L3 Magazine October 2012 issue, founded by Natasha Von Castle (L3 Magazine and L3Radio; Radio Regent), Natasha has been hailed as Canada's Music Queen. The beautiful

Current

Empress Minott became the first person in Europe to have two songs on the Karma Reggae Show Top 10 Count-Down Reggae Chart www.galaxygoldradio.co.uk with Dj Steve Stephens with "More Than Love" straddling the number one spot for three weeks and also "Treat Her Right" at number five. She is currently nominated as Top Reggae Artist in Canada on the Caribbean Music & Entertainment Award. She recently collaborated with Nanny Mystikk on a song called "Can We Go" of which she is the producer. The singer reads and shares her own inspirational quotes every Wednesday at 2PM Est. in the afternoon on the Zion Train with Host Natty B and Jah Chosen, which is broadcast live on www.chry.fm Rogers Cable 945 and Bell Five 973.

Songs like "Stumbling Blocks" and "Show Us the Way" are steadily flowing on most of, if not all the reggae shows in Canada and taking the airwaves by storm. She also finished two videos for both songs, which has been played on TVJ and CVM Television in Jamaica also on TV stations all around the world. "Stumbling Blocks" was also featured in a Canadian sitcom called "Da Kink in My Hair", which was aired on Global TV on March 19, 2009.

Empress Minott has now received a third of four successful nominations on November 25, 2012 and has held firm on the magic words "Hard work will pay off" this time around it was at the prestigious 3rd Annual P.E.A.B.O Awards (Promoters Entertainers and Business Owners) in Cambridge, Ont. which she was unanimously voted "Best Female Singer of the Year" 2011-2012. She gave a cameo performance with her hit song "Show Me". A song which has a compulsive vibration and soulful signature of this charismatic artiste.

Currently Empress Minott has been receiving worldwide airplay with the song "Can We Go" which features Nanny Mystikk. "Can We Go" was produced by Reality Records Limited and became the event title of a live performance stage show held December 28, 2012, Ontario, Canada. The show received a great review which was published by Eddie Grant in the Jamaica Gleaner (Canada) Jan 2013.

Empress Minott has now signaled she is ready for a successful worldwide touring career. In production also is her sophomore album to be release for 2013 a very high point/endeavor destined for the upcoming year.
